Dopamine - The Motivation Molecule

- Released when we accomplish goals
- Has the power to create motivation
- Triggers the brain to remember the material.
 - Set achievable goals and celebrate them when they are reached
 - Play games that get increasingly more challenging

Oxytocin - The Love Hormone

- Released when interacting with others
- Created while working with others in a playful and trusting environment.
 - Building a community within your classroom allows students to connect with and empathize with each other.
 - Conversations in the classroom allow students to learn from each other.

Serotonin - The Mood Stabilizer

- Released when relaxed and being mindful
- Serotonin comes when we acknowledge our success no matter how small
 - Teach breathing exercises to calm themselves
 - Begin or end class with a gratitude list created by everyone in the class
 - Sharing a snack with each other

Endorphins - The Pain Reliever

- Released during exercise
- Introduce mindfulness in your classroom as a regular procedure
 - Endorphins are released when there is laughter.
